



First Steps for Autism

Regional Therapy Program (0-7 years)



This five-day intensive therapy program is based on an individual assessment in collaboration with the family to identify the child's learning profile. We can provide your child with the opportunities to develop communication, social, play and motor skills while having fun with their peers. The program includes:

- Input from a trans-disciplinary team of Speech Pathologists, Occupational Therapists, Psychologists and Teachers
- Five days of intensive group and individualised therapy
- A functional assessment
- A Key Therapist will develop an individualised program, in collaboration with family goals
- Ongoing liaison with your Key Therapist throughout the week
- Parent training and coaching sessions
- Option to participate in ongoing regional web-conferences/Skype sessions with our specialist therapists
